Tickets are available until 11:59 p.m. Pacific Time TONIGHT. You can get your virtual ticket for free at rightscon.org/attend.



- **More impact from the Uber Files:** Last week, French lawmakers questioned Uber CEO Dara Khosrowshahi about Uber's aggressive lobbying tactics as revealed in the Uber Files. [Read ICIJ's report.](#)
