Thanks to his bravery, the French Parliament and Senate took notice. Hugo was received at the French Environment ministry, and French Prosecutors have opened an investigation that has included [police raids at the nuclear power plant and the French nuclear regulator office to seize evidence](#).

Hugo's revelations are contributing to improved nuclear safety in France. As is too often the case, wrongdoing was not revealed until one brave soul stepped up to sound the alarm.
